- Mountains and Landmarks:** Montes, and various smaller landmarks like the Fonte de Neper.
- Other Features:** The map includes numerous small icons representing settlements or fortifications. A note in the center-right states: "Tutti questi Tartari Settentrionali non hanno habitatione alcuna, salvo che portano con loro cari coperti di corame in loco di case." (All these Northern Tartars have no habitation at all, except that they carry with them covered carts in place of houses).
